Planned Upcoming Activities

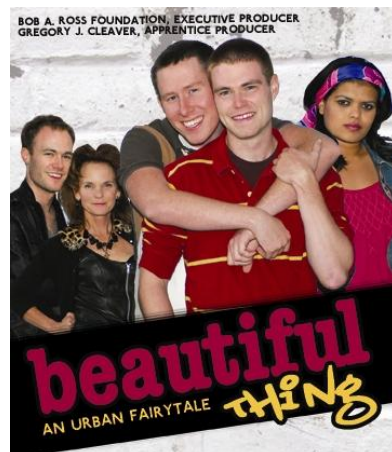
