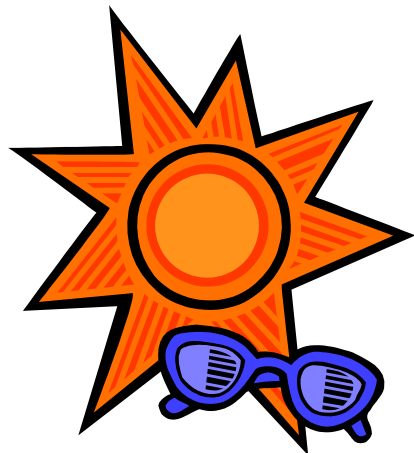

## Planned Upcoming Activities

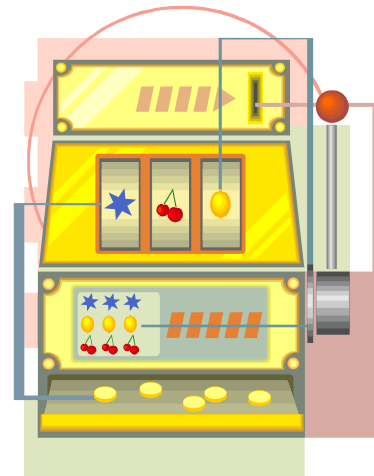
